Course Overview

Thriving in the Digital Age with Business Agility

New to the Scaled Agile Framework®? Leading SAFe offers you an introduction to the foundations of SAFe, and provides the principles and practices to confidently drive your Lean-Agile transformation. The course and resulting certification offer the guidance and tools to build a culture of resiliency and a shared language that engages employees and focuses on customers so that organizations can work with agility at scale.

Take a Leading SAFe course to discover how companies can build business agility, and how to make SAFe work inside your organization. You'll come away with an understanding of how to align your entire organization around the same clear objectives, and how to improve the flow of value and work from strategy to delivery. You'll learn what makes companies more customer-centric and how to run key SAFe alignment and planning events, like PI planning.

Who should attend?

The course is intended for C-suite people in an organisation, or anyone in a mid to senior leadership role who will be involved in adopting Business Agility.

Prerequisites & pre-reading guidelines

There is no prerequisite course or certification. Pre-reading suggestions are issued in a welcoming email to those registered for a course.

How certification is earned

Certification is earned by attending the course and then taking an exam within 30 days after the course. Questions are multiple choice, single-select. There are 45 questions to be answered in 90 minutes and the passing score is 80%. If a retake is needed there is an additional fee. The full retake policy is issued if and when needed.

 - How to establish Team and Technical Agility and organize around the flow of value
 - How to align massive organizations around clear, common objectives
