3.10 Managing Conflict and Difficult Behaviours

Course Overview

Workplace conflict and challenging behaviours can affect relationships, productivity and morale. Leaders must respond confidently, constructively and early to prevent escalation. This practical one-day programme equips participants with techniques to recognise conflict sources, communicate clearly and address difficult behaviours with professionalism.

Participants will learn to manage emotional responses, apply structured conflict resolution approaches and strengthen trust and collaboration within their teams.
